They are age-appropriate for young people in special school and can be used in primary school. They are easy for non-specialist teachers to use. Each song has a page indicating topic links and extension activities.

This song book and teaching CD has 64 songs that are short and easy to teach and learn. Many of them are rounds or simple harmony songs, and are great for signing or using Sam buttons.. The CDs enable you to hear each part sung on its own, as well as all the parts together.
