Signs

Come R index beckons.	Sing Both 2-finger-point hands alternate circles up from the mouth.
Joy L flat hand palm up, 2 R fingers 'jump' for joy.	I Index finger to own chest.
Say Index finger from mouth, forwards.	

Ideas for use in school

You can sing this song in 2, 3 or 4 parts.

You only really need 3 signs for this song – miss out 'I said' if you like.

A *Sam button singer could sing the whole of a part (often several times through, depending on the Sam button). You might to record a 'ramp' to enable everyone to join in together. This could be simply counting in, but it could also be a spoken phrase with a strong beat and obvious intonation.

e.g. 'Let's \ all \ sing right \ now. \ Come and \ sing, etc.

You can add a simple instrumental accompaniment, for Sam button players or other players.
