Lyrics

There is a word that is sometimes hard to say Sorry.

We all need to learn to say it anyway Sorry.

When I say 'I'm sorry', what will happen then? Sorry.

Then we will know that we can start again Sorry.

Signs

Sorry Rub small circles on chest with closed hand.	Word Thumb & finger as for 'C', hold pointing away from you. Don't move hand.
Hard / difficult R thumb touches L palm x2.	Say R index moves forward from mouth
We Index moves in arc from R chest to L chest.	Learn Open hand, palm facing you, move towards head & fingers bunch.
Anyway Both flat hands, palm towards you, thumbs up, in front of body, L nearer. Bend hands alternately in & out from wrists, fingertips brush.	When Fingers tap around R cheek.
What Index finger pointing up, palm away from you, move from side to side.	Happen / rise L flat hand in front of body, fingers pointing towards R. R index pointing hand moves up from behind.
Then / after / afterwards Index pointing up, palm away from you, make small movement L to R.	Know R closed hand, thumb out, taps forehead x2.
Start R closed hand, thumb out, brushes down L palm.	Again 2 fingers in V shape, held near R shoulder, swing forward x2.

Ideas for use in school

The lyrics are easy to sign - you'll certainly learn the word 'sorry'!

This can be sung as a round in 2 parts.

A *Sam button singer can lead the first group of singers in the round. Or s/he could sing one of the parts several times through. You might need to record a 'ramp' e.g. counting in, so that everyone knows when to start singing.

There are only 2 chords. You could record the instrument onto the Sam button.

*Sam (song/speech/sound and music) button – this is what I call the voice output communication devices like Step by Step, BigMac, 4Talk4 etc.
